- Tokyo Gendai became the first Japanese art fair to wrangle "bonded" status, meaning that visiting exhibitors will be exempt from the 10 percent sales tax that would otherwise have to be pre-paid on all artworks brought into the country regardless of whether or not they actually sell during the event.
